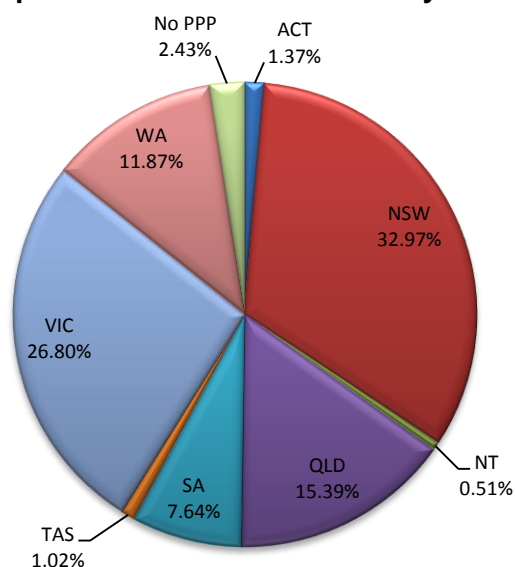


Chart 1: Practitioners by Principal Place of Practice

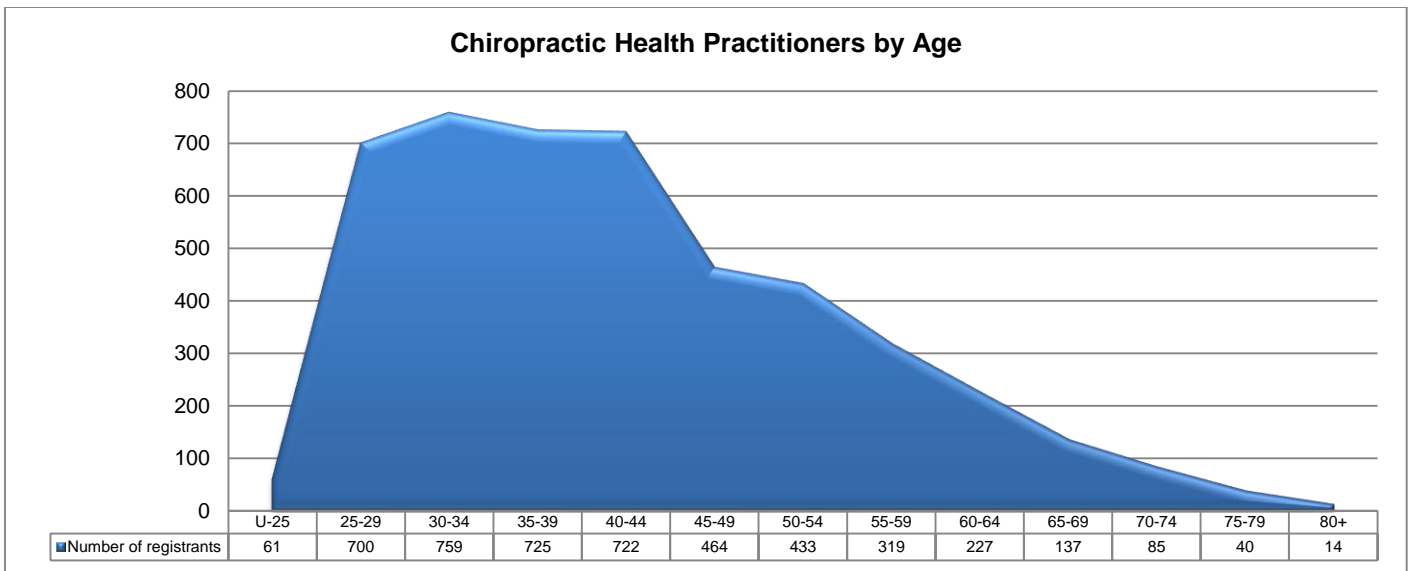


Chart 2: Practitioners by Age
