**3.4 Confidentiality and privacy**

b) state 'seeking consent from patients where practicable before disclosing information' ('where practicable' moved from the end of the sentence)

**4.1 Use of diagnostic and therapeutic modalities in chiropractic practice**

Second paragraph – '...skilled and qualified to *practise* any modalities used...'
