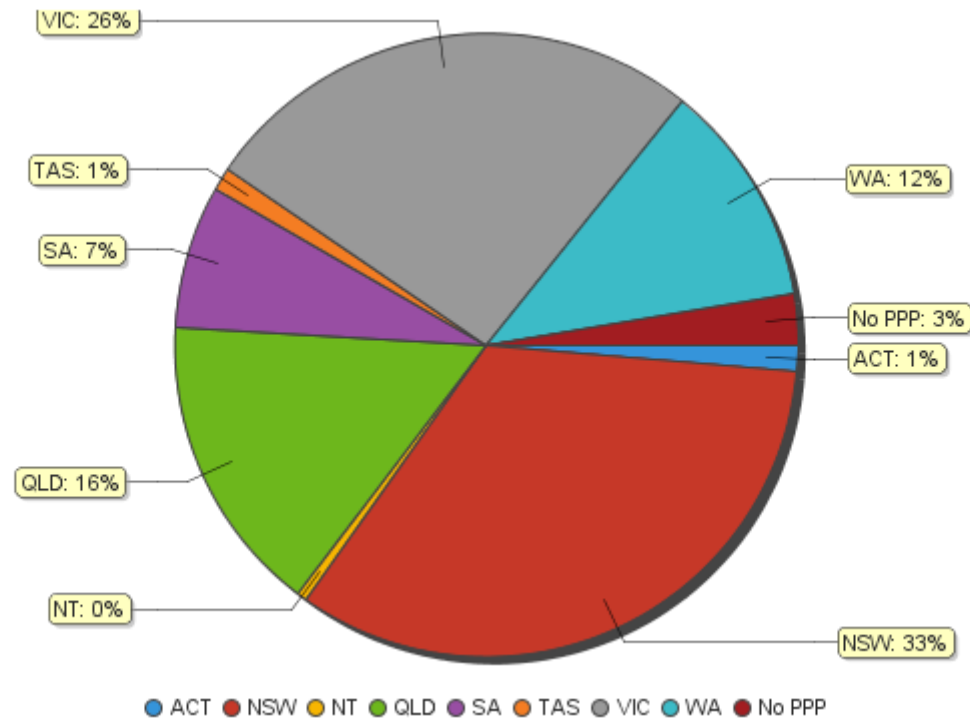

Chiropractic health practitioners – percentage by principal place of practice



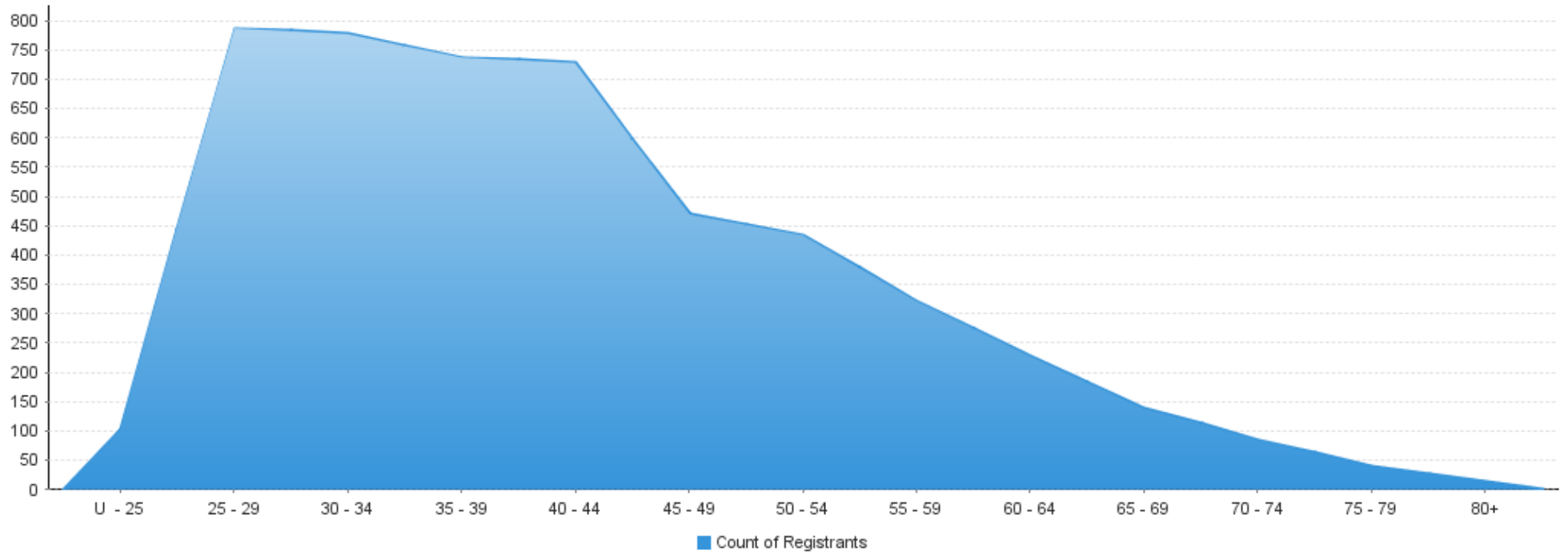
